

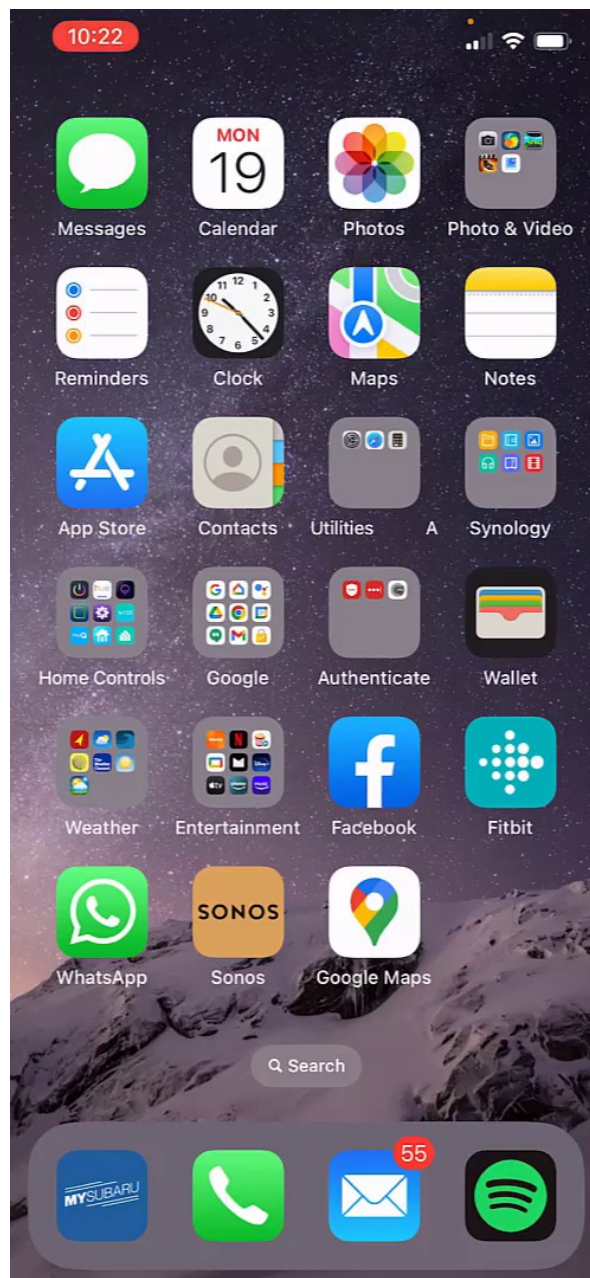
Change iOS Camera Settings for Compatibility

Set an iPhone or iPad camera to create photos and videos in formats that work with more websites and applications.

Before you begin: Follow WCPS FOIP, privacy, and approved-tool requirements whenever photos or videos contain student or staff information.

STEP 1 Open Settings

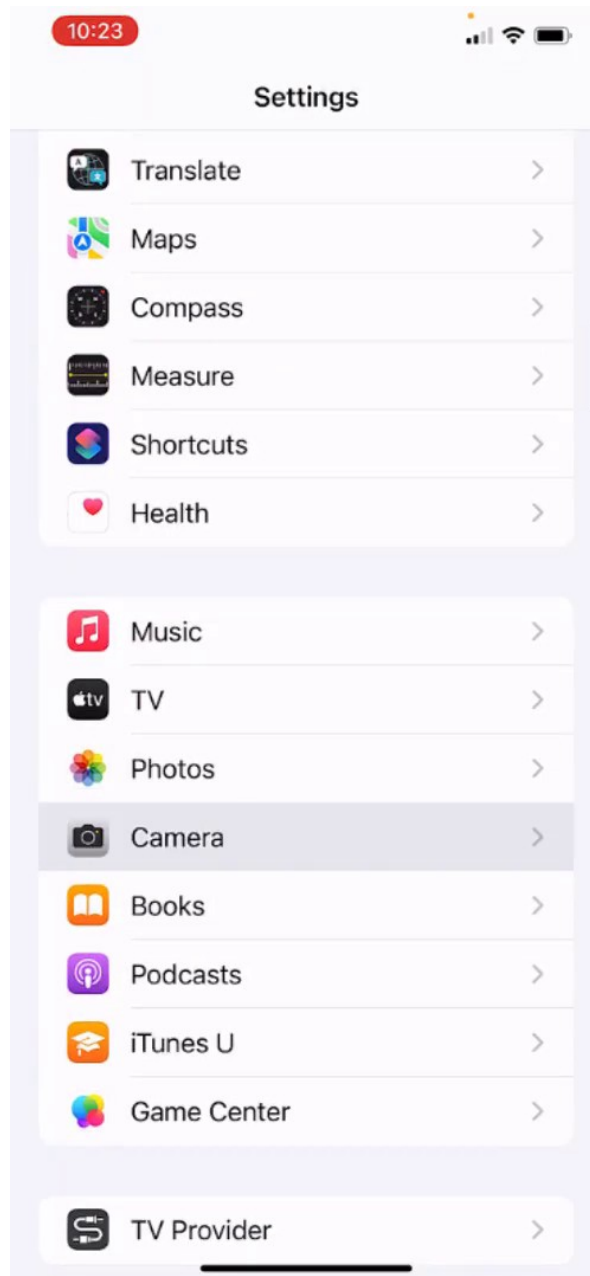
On the iPhone or iPad Home Screen, open the Settings app.

STEP 2 Open Camera settings

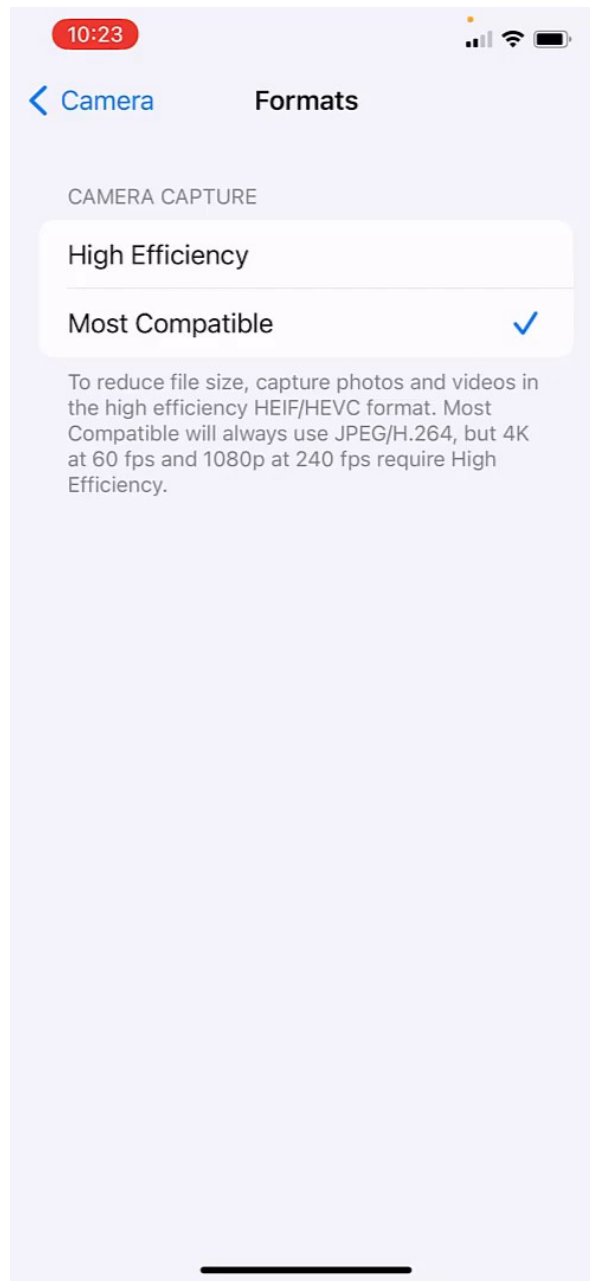
Scroll down in Settings, select Camera, and then select Formats.

STEP 3 Choose Most Compatible

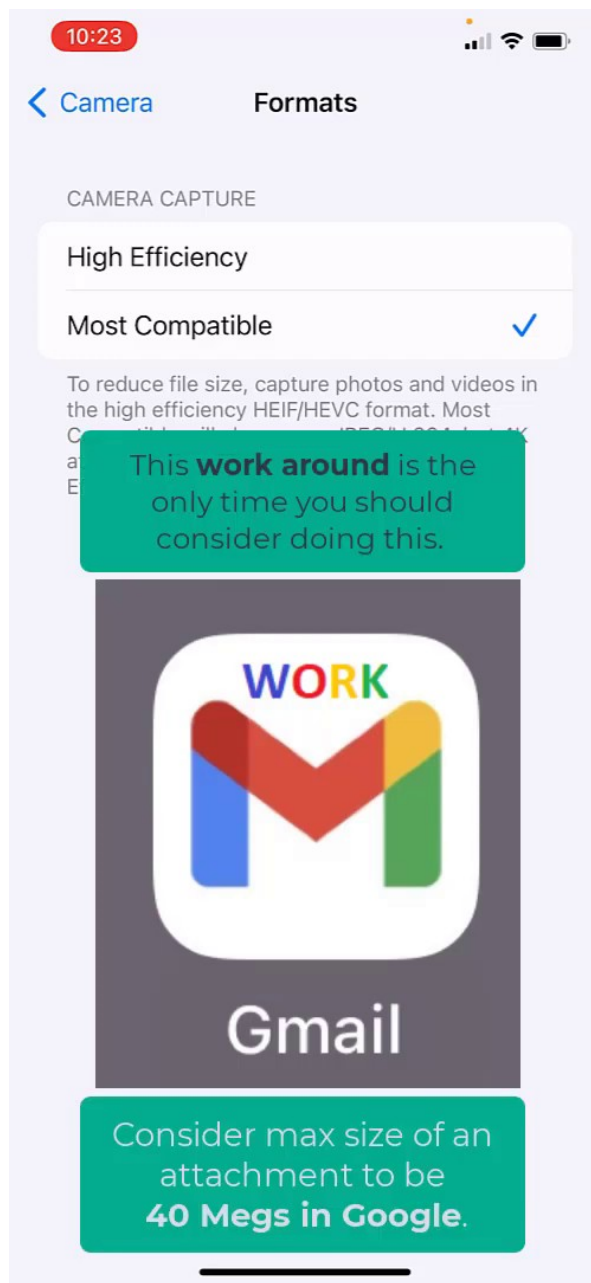
Under Camera Capture, select Most Compatible. New photos will use JPEG and new videos will use H.264 for broader compatibility.

STEP 4 Consider file size and privacy

More compatible files can be larger. Check attachment limits and continue to follow WCPS privacy requirements when sharing media.
