

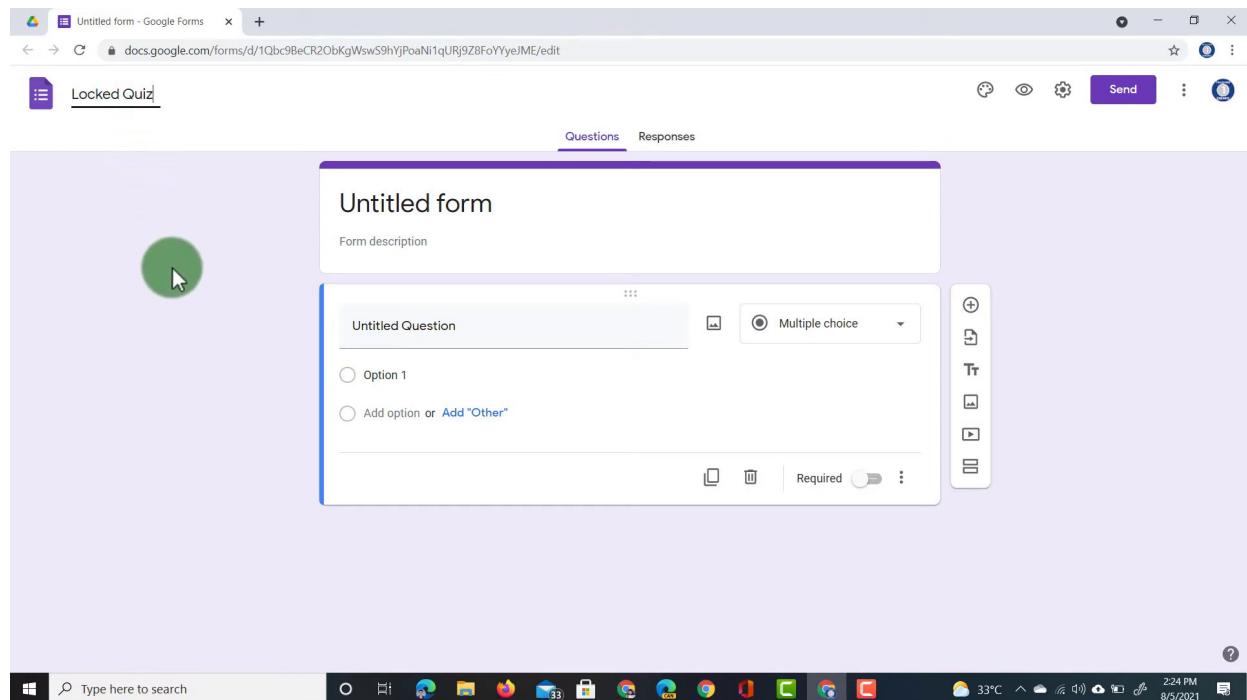
# Use Locked Mode in Google Forms Quizzes

Create a Google Forms quiz and restrict students on managed Chromebooks from opening other apps or browser tabs while it is active.

**Before you begin:** Locked mode works only on supported, managed Chromebooks. Confirm the quiz and student devices meet your school requirements before assessment day.

## STEP 1 Create the quiz

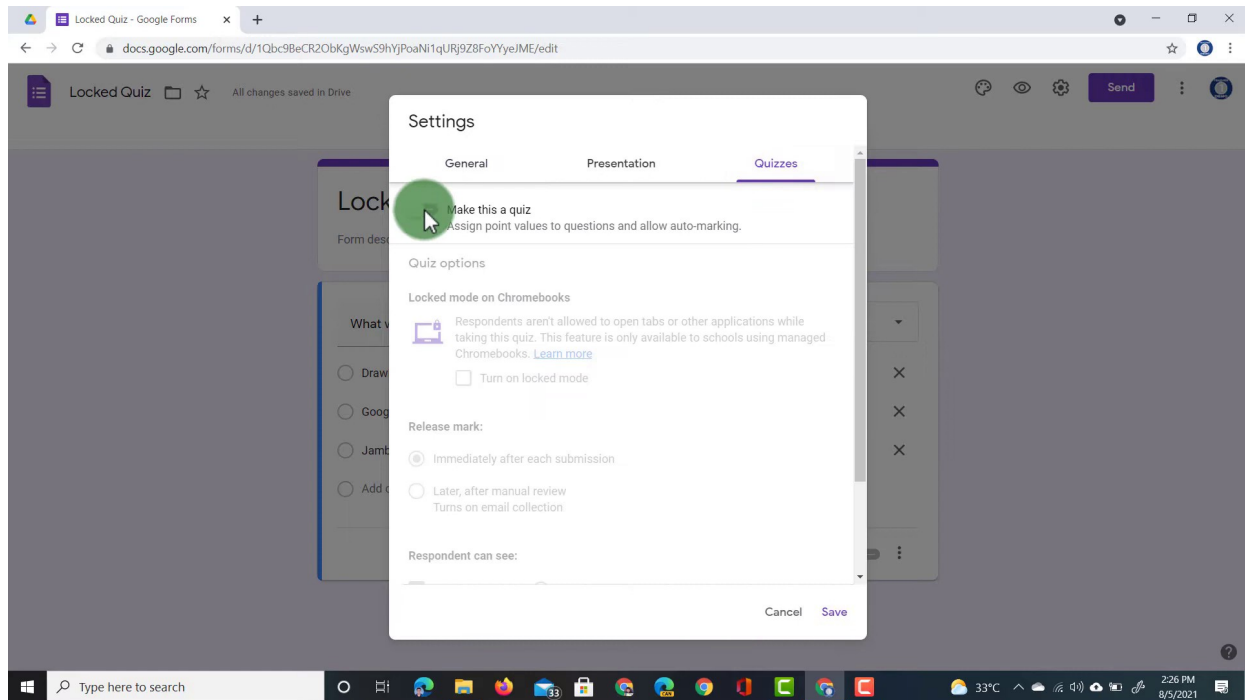
Open Google Forms, create a form, add the required questions, and give the assessment a clear title.

## STEP 2 Open quiz settings

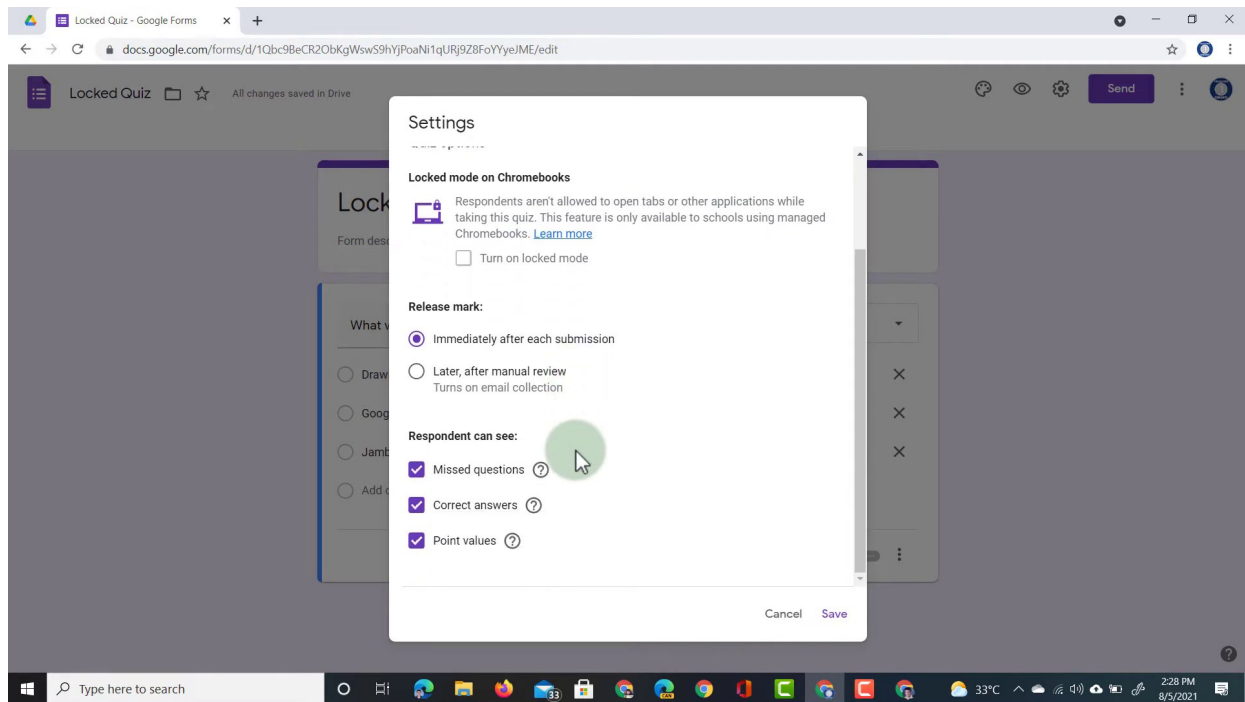
Select Settings and turn on Make this a quiz so answer keys and point values are available.

### STEP 3 Enable locked mode

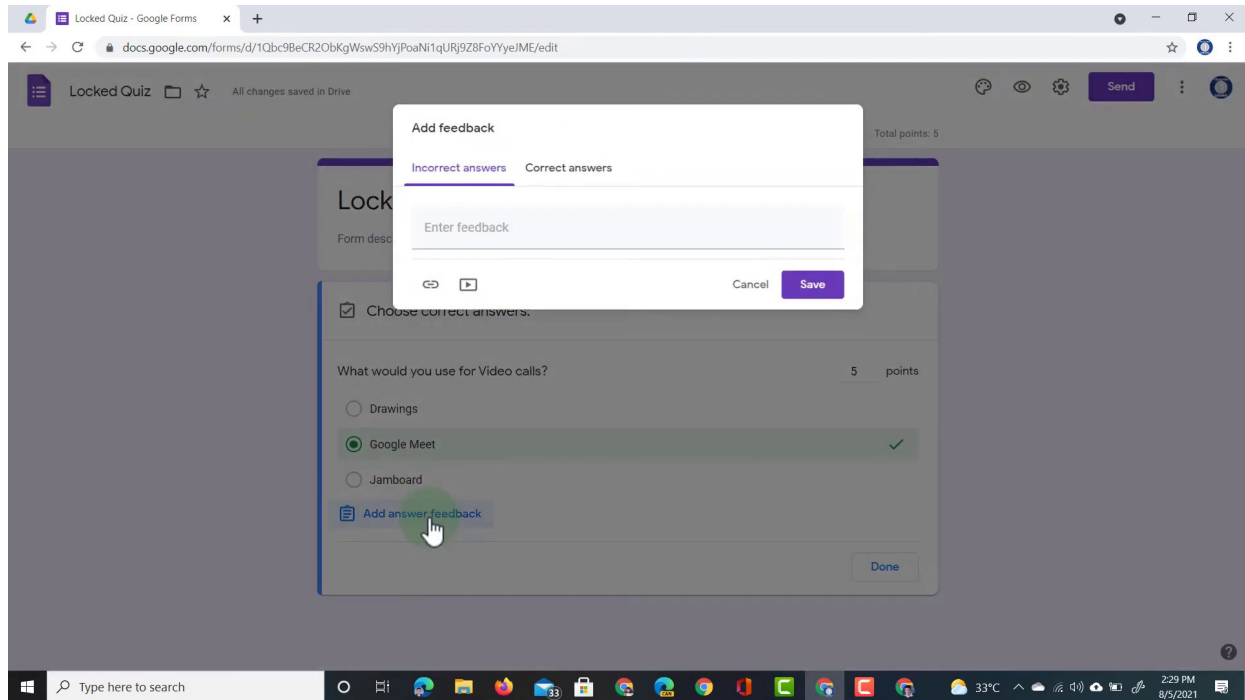
In the quiz settings, select Turn on locked mode. Review the warning and confirm this is appropriate for your students and devices.
